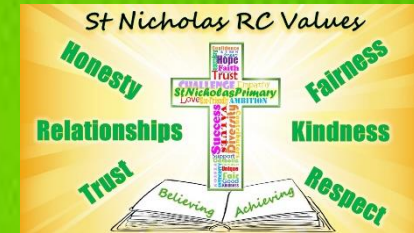


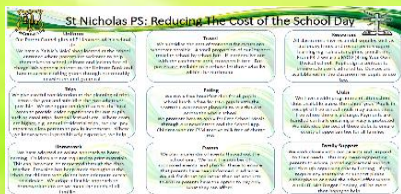

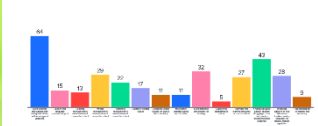

## Our Priorities

Support attendance for all learners, with a specific focus on Quintile 1 learners

Use of allocated participatory budget in consultation with all stakeholders

Reduce the Cost of the School day for all families

Support communication and language development across the school and ELC

Use targeted interventions to raise attainment in literacy and numeracy

Develop opportunities for family learning across the school and ELC

Promote positive wellbeing for targeted pupils

## What will we do?

DHT will monitor and support attendance in line with authority practices, using FVWL RIC attendance resource to target key groups across the year

Develop a pupil group to inform the wider school community of Cost of the School Day and allocate Participatory Budget effectively

Work in collaboration with our Parent Council to identify the ways in which we can take on board the advice of CPAG (Children's Poverty Action Group)

Fund Speech and Language Therapist to support our learners, families and staff to develop use of visuals to support communication across the school and ELC

Fund additional Pupil Support Worker staff (PSW) to run targeted intervention groups across literacy and numeracy with targeted learners

DHT and Raising Attainment teacher will develop an annual calendar of events based on needs analysis in consultation with parents, learners and staff

Implement additional wellbeing targeted interventions in addition to our social skills groups with targeted learners across the year
