Close the poverty related attainment gap between Q1 and Q5 as far as possible	Robust excellence and equity approaches will ensure that all children within our Quintile 1 cohort are supported appropriately
Look more closely at children within Quintile 2, supporting attainment and achievement	Begin to track the attainment and achievement of Quintile 2 children are we recognise they are at risk of being disadvantaged, with a higher population of our school falling within this bracket
Reduce the Cost of the School day for all families	Continue to build on our work to reduce the cost of the school day by profiling pupil voice and placing children's rights at the centre
Use targeted interventions to raise attainment in literacy and numeracy	Fund speech and language support and pupil support workers to target support using research based interventions and approaches
Increase attendance of Q1/FSME families at our breakfast club provision	Continue to raise the profile of our breakfast club provision and track the attendance/engagement of Q1/FSME
