- Leading equitable schools update- equity thematic review to take place in 3rd term with Cluster Equity Leads
- Raise awareness of Digital Wellbeing and Cyber Resilience. Following WLC advice on bring your own device from primary 4
- P7 sport leaders -supported by Active Schools. They can deliver lessons for each class and plan lessons for other children and can get a sport award then they can apply for saltire award. Agenda for pupil leadership skills
- Develop an outdoor growing space for food and plants
- Continue to collaborate with our cluster schools to develop a 'Building Thinking Classrooms' approach in numeracy
- Revising teaching to the teaching of Talking and Listening

News

- October newsletter has been sent out
- Parent consultation-feedback requested
- Cycle to school week pledge

Additional updates

- Parent portal- uptake (98% parents are set up on parent portal but staff no access to parent portal- only SLT and office staff). EE2 on the parent portal now
- School office- interruptions re: passing on messages- safeguarding needs to be the priority in the morning for office staff
- PVG- do all/some members of the PC need PVG? If you are making decisions on behalf of children, then likely need a PVG. Need to look into cost and who pays for this.

Any other business

- Halloween Sweets- Consensus of SK and PC that children get plenty of sweets over Halloween period- Voted against doing it this year.
- Curriculum Café- next one end of Oct. Funds for this are ear marked for p7 for camp. Cake stall that p7/p7 parents who run it. Linda Reape to lead on this.
- Movie/Disco Night- place on hold due to PVG. Action: investigate who needs PVG
 and how this effects any events that are run by PC. Need to be legally compliant
 with this.
- Nursery Support- nursery has not been supported by PC since before COVID until
 this year. Funds donated to them for the nursery garden. Support the nursery
 going forward and bring together the ELC with the school. 2 members of PC have
 children in the ELC.
- Music Mrs Conway. They have an offer from provider from someone who does African drumming. Supportive for children. Racial incidents happen but it would be a good way to celebrate culture. Cost £500 but opportunity for every child. They also do storytelling, assembly. In previous 2 years for culture day, there has been opportunities for pupils to bring in food, dress etc well received. Action: will PC support this?
- Family night fundraiser for PC- options for bingo, race night, beetle drive. Canon Hoban Hall is a good venue to use. Also links with Parish. End of January would be good timing for this. **Action** decide on plans for this.
- Christmas fayre. Mrs Macdonald would like to run the fayre. Proposed date for this 4th Dec. 5-8pm. Will be a joint effort between the school and PC.
- Nov 2026- St Nicholas will be celebrating 60 years of the building.
